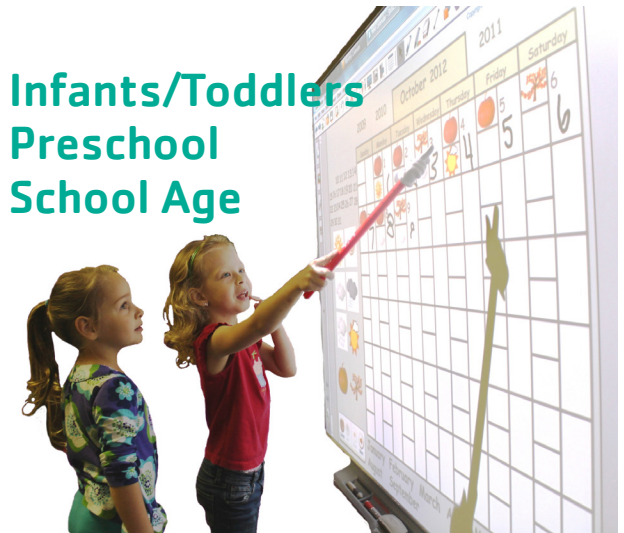

Serves children ages 6 weeks through 5 years. Our Infant, Toddler and Preschool Programs are designed to meet the individual growth and developmental needs of each child. An emphasis is placed on social interaction and developmentally appropriate hands-on activities. The core values of the YMCA are encouraged daily while children participate in various centers including: literacy/writing, science, construction, dramatic play, sensory, manipulatives, art and indoor/outdoor play.

The general curriculum includes:
